Progress Report/Tasks Completed:

- ◆ Corresponded with BREDE/Allied for furnishing exhibit at 2008 AAHPERD Convention
- ◆ Corresponded with board members and membership committee members to solicit volunteers to staff the exhibit booth at AAHPERD
- ◆ Registered individuals who would serve as "Exhibitors" for NAKPEHE at AAHPERD
- ◆ First draft of membership brochure under review with membership committee – should be ready in time for 2008 AAHPERD Convention
- ◆ Communicated with membership committee members via e-mail to establish this year's list of action items
- ◆ Two committee member, Carrie Moore and Brad Strand, have agreed to coordinate a new member lunch (or something similar) at the 2009 NAKPEHE Conference in Sarasota

Suggestions for Future Plans Related to this Office/Committee

- ◆ Membership committee should continue to work closely with vice presidents, future directions committee and public affairs committee
- ◆ Membership committee would like to work out a strategy for tracking recent (within past 10 years) recipients of the Hally Beth Poindexter Young Scholar and Jody Davenport Doctoral Poster awardees and encourage them to renew their membership in NAKPEHE
- ◆ Membership committee should work with vice president to disseminate information about the upcoming NAKPEHE conference AND reserving and staffing the NAKPEHE exhibit at AAHPERD

Action Required by Board:

- ◆ The membership committee moves that first time conference attendees receive a 25% reduction in conference fees.
  - Rationale: members of this committee feel that this reduction in conference registration fees for first time conference attendees could appeal to folks who may feel that the ≈\$200 conference registration fee is too expensive. The committee had discussed the possibility of moving for a reduction in membership dues, but the dues are more intricately “tied” to subscriptions to *Quest* and *CKPEHE*.
  - Logistics: Perhaps there can be a box on the registration form where people can “check” if this is their first conference. If they check the box, then the on-line form can “recalculate” their conference fees.

Budget Implications:

- ◆ If our motion passes, then the vice president and her or his planning committee would need to take any possible reductions in conference income into consideration in budget planning for the annual conference.
